## TRICKLE DOWN <br> -RULES OF THE GAME-

Trickle Down is an easy, tactical board game for three players. One game session takes about 10-15 minutes.

## Setting Up the Game

Place the money bags in the middle of the game board in the order shown in the picture:


Choose your own symbol (triangle, square or circle) from the purple hexagons of the game board. Each player owns the companies on opposite sides of the game board, marked with symbols of the same color and shape.


## The Goal of the Game

Collect as much money bags for the areas of your own companies as you can. The player who has collected the most money for themself in the end wins.

## Rules

1) Money bags are shared by all players. All players can move all bags.
2) On their turn, the player must move one bag. The bag can either be moved to an adjacent empty hexagon, or it can jump directly over one bag to the empty hexagon behind it (see pictures).
3) The bags cannot be moved back closer to

the center of the board. They can only be moved on the perimeter they are on or closer to the outer edges of the board.
4) The player cannot move the bag moved by the previous player in the previous turn, back to where the previous player originally moved the bag from. A bag can be moved back if another bag has been moved in between.
5) When the bag ends up in one of the companies' territory (purple hexagons) on the outer perimeter of the board, it may no longer be moved. The bag stays in that hexagon until the end of the game.
6) If the bag ends up in a neutral public service hexagon in the corner of the game board, it is moved off the board, and placed next to the public service hexagon in question.

## Ending of the Game

The game ends when there are no more moveable bags on the board.

Add up the values of the money bags in each player's company areas:

- Bags with wooden pennies (orange) €1 million
- Bags with silver pieces (blue) $€ 2$ million
- A bag containing gold coins (gold) €3 million

The player with the most money wins!
